Launceston - 21st December

Arrive into Launceston by 4pm to check into your hotel. Meet in the evening for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant (D)

Launceston & Tassie's North East - 22nd December

After a morning cruise in the Cataract Gorge you'll explore the North East region of Tasmania, tasting some of the local delicacies on the way, including a vineyard, distillery and lavender farm. (B,L,D)

Launceston to Cradle Mountain - 23rd December

This morning you take a guided tour of the Beaconsfield Heritage & Mine Museum before driving through the rolling farm land and winding forest roads to Cradle Mountain. You stop to take in a relaxed lunch overlooking the Western Tiers before time to explore the quaint village of Sheffield. This evening you will enjoy a private nocturnal wildlife tour within Cradle Mountain National Park. (B,L,D)

Cradle Mountain - 24th December

After a leisurely morning, today you take a tour of the stunning Gunns Plains Caves before a delicious lunch and tasting at a local vineyard. Arriving back at Cradle Mountain, the afternoon is yours to spend at leisure before a sumptuous group dinner at the lodge. (B,L,D)

Cradle Mountain - 25th December

Hobart & Bruny Island - 28th December

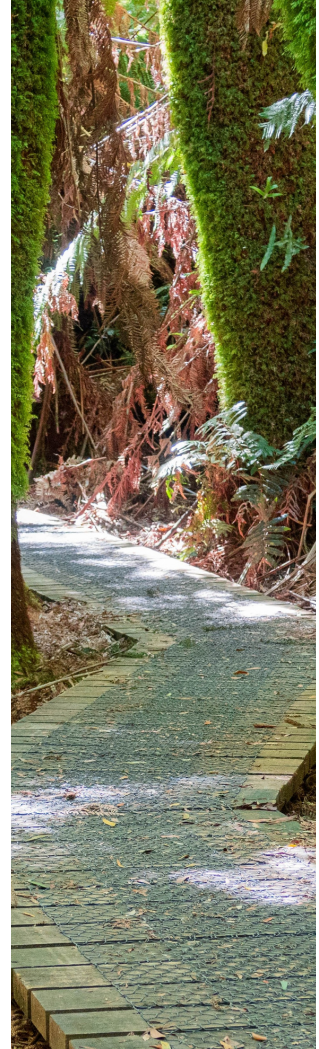
